This questionnaire was given to you in order to best analyze one or more problem behaviors in your cat(s). Please answer each question as accurately as possible. - 1. General information Owner(s):
  - a. Please list names, ages, sex, of all people in your household:
  - b. Please describe your house or apartment, number of rooms, etc.
  - c. How long at this address?
  - d. List any significant changes in the household including any change in number of household members or pets, construction within or outside home, new furniture, sources of stress for family members, etc.
- 2. Animals:
  - a. List in order of obtaining them, all pets in your household. Include when obtained, age, sex, personality, medical history, anything you can think of that may explain interrelationships.

b. Describe in detail what, how often, and where you feed your pets.

c. Describe the litter box plan for your home: how many, where placed, type of box, type of litter. Draw diagrams of their placement if you wish.

d. Describe in detail each behavior of each animal, that you consider a problem. List and describe the behaviors by each animal, when, where, how often, and how long they have been occurring. **Be as detailed as possible**.

- 4. Please describe any methods used to correct the behaviors prior to filling out this questionnaire.
- 5. Would you consider seeing a veterinary behaviorist for these problems?
